







A "PROBLEM" is identified that causes people to want to DO DOMETHING about it






We begin to come up with ideas to DESIGN the CHANGE we want to see, thinking about —who, what, when where and how






We create models of how things can work, and begin to try them out, we IMPLEMENT the MODELS —that means we start using them






News about successful models spreads, and we RE-CREATE the MODELS in more places

 - severe to profound
- treatment and conditions in institutions exposed
- parent "associations" create classrooms and schools
- "special", "vulnerable", "different"
- group programs created as safe places in community
- "home like", "work like" experiences




Person directed individualized




- two Ministry funding arrangements:





more than **\$2 billion** spent on Developmental Services




more than \$1.6 billion spent on Agency Directed Service contracts








